Albion at Bermuda

Sir the 3rd November 1814

My despatches by the Pigmy will
have informed you of the arrival here of
the Armide and Portia, I have the honor
now further to report to you the arrival on
the Evening of the 8th Instant of the Wolovine
with the Convoy from Providence for England,
for to refer to and the Amphion bringing Convoy to this
Page 31 in the place from England, the latter Ship (as
New Book you will perceive by a Letter transmitted
amongst the accompanying Despatches)
being under Orders from the Lords of the
Admiralty to return to England from
hence with Convoy if any such offered
otherwise to cruise in her way home. — On
perceiving the Wolovine's Muster in the
Offing I had ordered the Diadem forthwith
to proceed with the Dolphin and such
Trade as was ready to accompany her, and

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
