In answer to your Letter of this date I beg to acquaint you that I conceive the Duke of Brontë's three Transports named in the Margen Bridges - may be sent to England under convoy of the Amphion (which Ship is to sail about the 22^d Instant) if they can be got ready

I have to desire you will cause the repairs of the Eolus to be made good with as little delay as possible on board which Transport the Army breaching for the 29th Regiment can be put

So soon as a Tank can be spared you can have one to complete the water of the Jubilee and Eolus
