In compliance with the Order
which you addressed to Vice Admiral
Sir Alexander Cochrane under date the 1st November
last, I herewith transmit a Passport
for any Vessel (under Three hundred Tons
Burthen) to proceed from Baltimore to
Martinique and Guadeloupe with French
Passengers.

You will observe it is stipulated
that such Vessel sail under a Neutral flag,
but you will understand it will not be
required of her to produce any further proof
of Neutral Character.
