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refused to continue under your Orders, she
will therefore take the Wolverine's place
which by your Letter I suppose will have
sailed with Convoy to the Windward Islands.
Whenever the Wolverine returns you will
be pleased to order her to join me.

The Trade for Honduras and the
Transport with the Baggage of the 21st
Regiment may be placed under the
protection of any vessel going to join the
Commander in Chief or joined to any
Convoy which may be going to Jamaica.

The arrival at Jamaica of the Expedition
which lately sailed from the Chesapeake
having been publicly notified in the
American Papers, if you have not already
had occasion to do it, you will ^{now} be pleased
to open for your further guidance the
Sealed Rendezvous of the Commander in
Chief which was left with you.

I am glad to learn you propose
sending the Slops and Stores demanded by
the Chesapeake Squadron in the Madagascar
they are all much in want of them, the scarcity
of Rope under 3 inch and of Lark at Bermuda
mentioned by you is much to be regretted, it
