

Such Articles as are before mentioned specified, and bound
to the before mentioned Countries, are to be protected by His
Majesty's vessels under my Commission. You therefore
govern yourself accordingly.

12th August. 1812.

There has been written a letter subsequent to the
above order, to Chevalier D'Onis, His Catholic Majesty's
Minister in America, something similar to that written to
Mr Allen, on the same subject. Accordingly all vessels
having a Copy Certified by him, are to be protected. I
have granted a protection to Mr Charles Brasferot, to import
a cargo of dry Goods to a port in the United States likewise
one to Mr Elijah Mox; their vessels will hoist the following
flags on the approach of any His Majesty's vessels.
