By an Officer just from Benidic
I am informed that the enemy are in move-
ment, one large ship, two schooners, and a
number of barges came up (sounding) last night
near that place, that the Admiral with
another ship is in the river below, and
fourth ship, two schooners, were up the Bay.
Mr. Skinner has likewise come up from Falou.
This morning he gives the same information.
The Officers says the two Battalions of the 36th & 33rd
are on their way to this place, and adds, that
he understands they are to cross here, and
proceed upwards.
