Lastly I hereby constitute & appoint my Friends James Roe & James Baynard or either of them Executors of this my last Will & Testament & appoint Mr. Roe & James Baynard or either of them Guardians to my Children George & William Medford - I Witness whereof I have set my hand & Seal this third day of September Anno Domini Eighteen hundred & Sixteen.

Maryland Hunt County to Wit September 24. 1816 Then came John Ferguson one of the subscribing Witnesses to the foregoing Will and Codicil of George G. Medford late of Hunt County dec'd and made oath on the holy Evangelists of Almighty God that he saw the Testator herein named sign and seal this Will and Codicil and that he heard him publish pronounce and declare the same to be his last Will and Testament that at the time of his so doing he was to the best of their apprehensions of sound disposing Mind memory and understanding and that James M. Anderson and Sam Medford the other subscribing Witnesses were present at the same time that they all subscribed their names as witnesses to this Will and Codicil in the presence of and at the request of the said Testator and in the presence of
