are held and firmly bound unto the state of Maryland, in the full and just sum of *(Five) Hundred*

pounds, current money, to be paid to the said state of Maryland: To which payment well and truly to be made and done, we bind ourselves, and every of us, our and every of our heirs, executors, and Administrators, in the whole, and for the whole, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals, and dated this *fifth* day of *March* in the year of our LORD, 1785.

T H E Condition of the above Obligation is such, that if the above bound *Phillip Reed*

execut^r of the last will and testament of *Hannah Reed* late of *Kent* county, deceased, do make, or cause to be made, a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods, chattels and credits of the said deceased, which have, or shall come to the hands knowledge, or possession of *him* the said *Phillip Reed* or into the hands and possession of any other person or persons, for *him* and the same so made, do exhibit, or cause to be exhibited, into the office for registering of wills for the county aforesaid, at or before the *fifth* day of *June* next ensuing. And the same goods, chattels and credits, and all other the goods, chattels, and credits of the said deceased, at the time of *her* death, which at any time after shall come to the hands or possession of the said *Phillip Reed* or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for *him* do well and truly administer according to law, viz. shall pay the debts of the said deceased, so far forth as the said goods, chattels, and credits will extend, and the law will charge. And further, do make, or cause to be made, a true and just account of *his* said administration, at or before the *fifth* day of *March* next: And all the rest and residue of the said goods, chattels and credits which shall be found remaining upon the said administrat^{on} account, the same being first examined and adjusted by the judge or judges, for that purpose commissioned and appointed, for the time being, do distribute and dispose according to law, and the true intent and meaning of the last will and testament of the said deceased; then this obligation to be void, and of none effect, or else to remain in full force and virtue.
