hundred dollars. Do. I give & bequeath unto my daughter
Jane Medford all the remainder of my Estate to be
paid her at the age of sixteen years. Lastly I appoint
Geo. J. Medford my son Executor of this my last will
and testament. In Witness whereof I have here-
unto set my hand & affixed my seal this Twenty-eighth
day of October Anno Domini 1805. *Peatrice Medford*
signed sealed & deliv^d in the presence of us.

Codicil. - Whereas I Peatrice Medford of Kent
County have made & duly executed my last will & testa-
ment in writing bearing date 28th. October 1805.
which said will I do hereby ratify & confirm (except
such bequeaths as therein mentioned as now by this
are revoked & void) do therefore hereby make this my
Codicil, which I will & direct shall be held as
part of my will & Testament as follows that is to say.

Whereas by my said will I did give & bequeath unto
my daughter Editha one negro woman named Amy,
a horse & carriage & the sum of One hundred Dollars,
now I do hereby revoke the said legacy except the sum
of One hundred Dollars, which still is to be paid her.

Item. I give unto my son Geo. J. Medford one
negro woman named Amy. I give unto my daugh-
ter Jane my Horse & Carriage. In Witness
Whereof I have this 19th. day May 1808. set
