George Medford. Kent Co. Sept 4 1761

- (1.) Devise to son George Medford Jr.  
all those parcels of land mortgaged to me  
by James Tipp<sup>son</sup>, Kent Co, quantity of 320 ac<sup>+</sup>  
first part being 250 ac<sup>+</sup> called Mill Fort  
the remaining 70 acres call'd Tippett's  
Adventure per afd mortgage as  
mortgage is not yet foreclosed etc etc  
and if George dies without issue shall  
descend unto my son Marmaduke Medford  
~~by~~ but since my eldest son Tho<sup>s</sup> Medford  
is now settled thereon he shall not  
be disturbed until the death of my loving  
wife Jane Medford
  - (2) Personal property already in possession  
of my son Thomas shall remain his and  
further give s<sup>d</sup> Thomas a looking glass the  
largest of the two in the Hall, six head of sheep,  
one new gun and an eight day Clock in full  
of his part of my personal estate.
  - (3) Already given to my daughter Mary,  
the wife of Ebenezer Blackstone and upon  
a Tortoise Shell Silver Snuff box plus  
that already in her possession
  - (4) Loving wife Jane Medford shall have  
my dwelling plantation and all my Lands  
adjoining during the time she shall remain a widow  
also a Negro woman Dinah, a riding chair  
and <sup>my</sup> horse she shall make choice of in  
case she remain a widow.
  - (5) On her death I give to my children the following  
Negroes. To son George Jr., Jonas & Gran?  
to son Marmaduke, Will and Amy, to daughter  
Mary Pail and Venus.
  - (6) daughter Augustina not capable to manage an estate
  - (7) daughter Jane Medford \$50
- Marmaduke and wife Jane executors
