President of the Court Martial for the trial
of the late Master George St. John, and Edward L. Young
apprehensive the enemy would pay us another visit on
their return from up the bay, I was anxious to have their
case determined. I enclose you will receive the proceedings
of George L. Davis the Court after mature deliberation
on the testimony adduced, find the prisoner Sailing
Master Edward L. Young, guilty of the Charge exhibited
against him, and sentence him to be suspended for four
Calendar months, from this date 22nd July 1813, with
out pay, or emoluments, which sentence has been appro-
ved by your Obedient Servant. Agreeable to the 45th
Article of the laws for the better government of the Army
of the United States.

On the Court being divided a question
was made by the Court whether the prisoner be confined
being.
