Alexandria Aug 5 1813

Sir

In consequence of your illegal
detention of the ship *Patric Trader* from the protection
of her voyage to Cadix, not prohibited by any law
of the United States - & the total loss of that voyage
I do hereby, on behalf of whom it may concern,
demand of you the whole cargo of the said ship
consisting of four thousand nine hundred thirty
two whole & four hundred forty seven half barrels
of flour, and shall look to you for full compensation
for all loss and damage, which has been or may
be sustained from the said detention. -

The Bearer of this note, Mr. Mandeville, will
deliver to you a copy of Capt. Lewis's Protest,
which I leave you for your own consideration. -
