round 50 shot. 200, 24 Gauge 150, 18 lbs Gauge
and 50 Gauge for Columbiads. 50 Cartridges
for 24 lbs & 50 Cartridges for 18 lbs.

From our own Department we have
again complete rations, and I should suppose
three weeks rations for 200 men would be suffi-
-cient, at all events for a first supply.
