Sir,

The enemy's force this evening consists of 4. 74's off Sandy point. near which are one 64. - 3 Frigates - three smaller ships, one brig & three tenders - Several miles above is, one 50

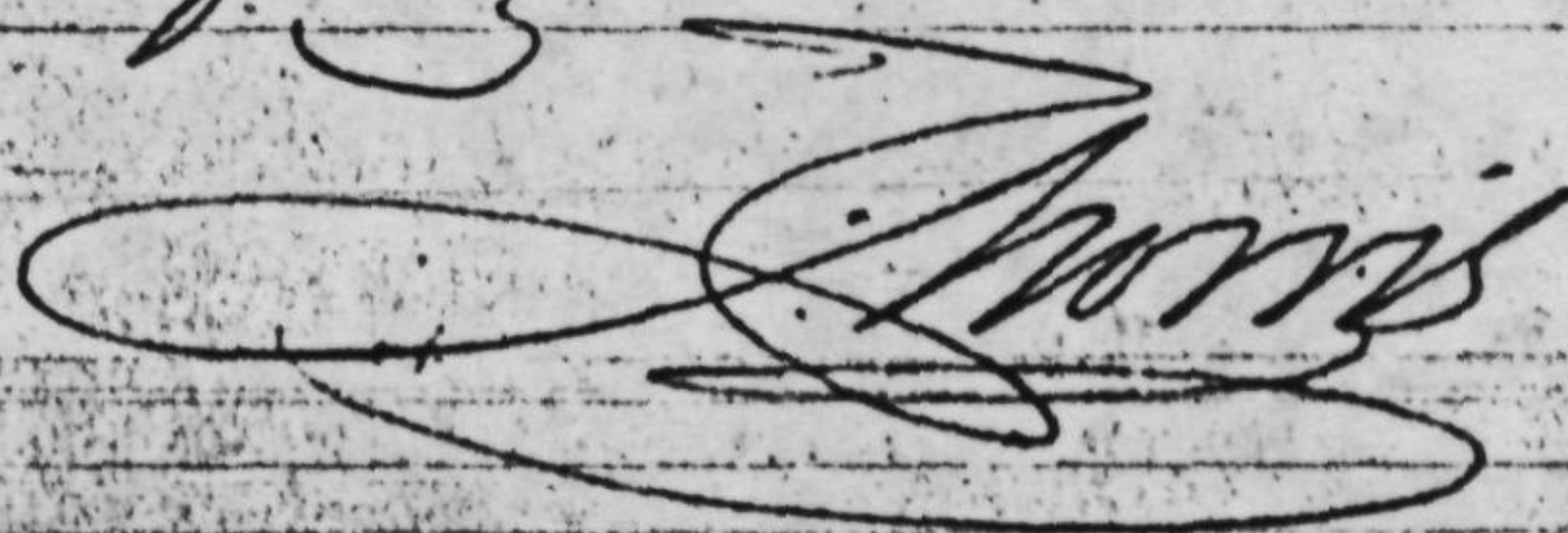
gunship. & one Frigate - and several miles below, one ship of the line 74, and three tenders

A Brig looked into the harbor just before sunset, and stood to the Admiral again - The present night is very favorable to an attack from boats should they meditate one - We

have adopted such measures as circumstances will permit, but without hope or permission

shot we can disturb boats but little in the night
