

Albany August 27th 1813

Dear Sir

The enemy remain in the same situation as when I last wrote with the exception of the Marlborough which has been added down the Bay. Their attention for the present appears to be directed to the eastern shore, upon which they have made several attacks by their barges and small vessels.

They yesterday returned from an enterprise of this nature, which I fear was successfully directed against St. Michaels, at which place several vessels were building and at anchor -

but none remain in health -
