The proceedings of the general court martial, in the case of Lieutenant William S. Cox, midshipman James W. Forrest, acting midshipman Henry P. Trenchman, William Brown, bugleman, Joseph Russel, captain of the second gun, Peter Frost and John Joyce, seamen, late of the United States Frigate "Chesapeake" captured by the British ship of War "Shannon" having been submitted for the decision of the President and Secretary of the Navy of the United States, according to the nature of the respective sentences, the following extract therefrom is ordered to be read by the commander of every ship and the commandant of each naval station to those under their command and to be published in the National Intelligencer of the city of Washington.
