Sir,

I have the honor to inform you that the Agent has shipped by the Floor Mechanic, Isaac Redman master, who left here yesterday, one thousand & eighteen pound round shot, which I found our inspection by the gauge received from Washington - We are now waiting on board another vessel 12 or 1500 move by the inspection of the gauge made agreeable to the written orders of General Handworth, which order I have seen myself, & by comparing his dimensions with the gauge in possession of Mr. Dorsey I find it very precise, & have in consequence of a letter inspected the rest by that, & have ordered our gauge to be altered to suit -

The officers & crew of the late U. S. Brig. *Thetis* will proceed to Washington as soon as a conveyance can be procured - Recruits for the *Thetis* will be the *Argos* at present -

Dr. Page being ordered to Washington for a review it necessary to detain the Surgeon of the *Thetis* a few days to attend our few sick -
