I am compelled again to be troublesome to you, but it is my misfortune; and have taken the liberty of enclosing a report made by Lieutenant Graham of the sailing master, Edward L. Young, for disobedience of orders -

There is also one Boatswain, one Steward confined for mutinous expressions, and two Marines for disobedience of orders belonging to the Frigate; being so much engaged watching the enemy that a Court has not been able to sit on the trials of Sailing master Fitzhugh. Should it meet your approbation I should be glad of orders for a General Court to convene as soon as convenient for the trial of the whole.
