1. BORDELAIS engaging three French warships simultaneously, on January 29, 1801. LA CURIEUSE is sinking; a second Brig LA MUTINE and the schooner L'ESPERANCE are fleeing.

2. RACOONS capturing Lodi off Haiti July 11, 1803; painted for Lady Glenberrie. NMM Negative D8458-C

3. ^{French ship} POMONE reduced to a wreck at Pelagosa, where Gordon lost his lower left leg when hit by a 36 pound ball which ^{hit} his knee joint on 30 November 1811. NMM Negative PU5813.
