Rear Admiral on every occasion, ~~after~~ having completed the Enterprise, he returned agreeably to his orders, and rejoined your Royal Highness's Memorialist his Commander in Chief at the Bay of Chesapeake.

The ~~mentioned~~ aforesaid American Brig Quaconda upon being captured, was sent with her Stores and Cargo to Halifax, and the aforesaid Schooner Atlas after her capture, was sent with her Stores and Cargo to Bermuda, where they were regularly condemned as Prizes in the respective Courts of Vice Admiralty,

Your Royal Highness's Memorialist therefore for himself as Commander in Chief as well as on behalf of the Flag Officers, Officers of the Land Forces and all other Officers and Men serving in the said Expedition, Most Humbly prays, that your Royal Highness will be graciously pleased to order a Grant to be made of the Proceeds of the aforesaid Enemy's Vessels, their Stores & Cargoes, to be divided and distributed to them in such manner, as to your Royal Highness may seem meet.
