To His Royal Highness the Prince Regent
in Council

The Memorial of John Dougan of London
Esq^r as Agent and on behalf of Rear
Admiral Cockburn and Lieutenant
Colonel Charles Napier. —

Humbly Sheweth.

That in the Month of July 1813 a Squadron of
His Majesty's Ship under the Command of Rear
Admiral George Cockburn and a Detachment of the
107th Regiment and of the 2nd Battalion of Royal
Marines under the Command of Lieut^{nt} Colonel Napier
Acting on a Conjoint Expedition on the Coast of the
United States captured in Ocracoke Bay an American
Brig called the Annaconda and an American Ship
named the Atlas and their Cargoes the former of
which was sent to Halifax and the latter to the
Island of Bermuda for Adjudication.

That proceedings were duly instituted against
the said Ships and Cargoes in the Vice Admiralty
Courts at Halifax and Bermuda and the said Brig
Annaconda and her Cargo were by Sentence of the
Judge of the said Court of Vice Admiralty at Halifax
on the 7th of October 1813 condemned as lawful
Prize to His Majesty seized and taken as aforesaid
and the said Ship Atlas and Cargo were in the
Month of October 1813 also in like manner condemned
to His Majesty in the Vice Admiralty Court at Bermuda.

That the said vessels and Cargoes were afterwards
Sold and the Proceeds thereof are now remaining at
His Majesty's disposal no Orders having been
issued by His Majesty for the Distribution of
Property captured on the said Conjoint Expedition. —
