

Consider the Statement of the Facts in this Case, it appeared, that the Sentence of Condemnation in the "Atlas", had not expressed the Capture to have been made by a Conjoint Expedition, but had appeared to Condemn the vessel in the form of a Maritime Capture; ~~and~~ On reference to the Agents, we are informed, that the Capture of both vessels and Cargoes, was made on the same day, at the same place, and by the Forces Naval and Military under Rear Admiral Cockburn, and ~~Colonel Napier~~ Colonel Napier - That the Captors considered both to be Condemned to His Majesty, as captured by the Conjoint Force above mentioned; and that the same Parties, share for both vessels and Cargoes." -

It will therefore be proper to direct the grant to issue agreeably to the Prayer of the Petition.
