Whereas there was this day read at the Board
a Report from a Committee of the Lords of His
Majesty's most Honourable Privy Council, dated the
2nd of this Instant in the words following, Viz! -

Memorandum - Here the Committee Report
for granting the Proceeds of the American
Ships "Anaconda" and "Atlas", captured in
Ocracock Bay, was inserted at length -
as Vide Entered Page -

His Royal Highness The Prince Regent
having taken the said Report into Consideration,
was pleased, in the Name and on the behalf of
His Majesty and by and with the Advice of His
Majesty's Privy Council to approve thereof, and
also of the said Draught of Instrument for giving
and granting to the said Rear Admiral Sir George
Cockburn and Lieutenant Colonel Charles Napier
the Proceeds of the said Ships and Cargoes In Trust
to distribute the same to and amongst such Persons
as may be entitled thereto, according to the Plan
of Distribution laid down in the said Draught
of Instrument. And His Royal Highness doth
hereby Order, in the Name and on the behalf
aforesaid, That the Right Honourable Earl Bathurst
one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State,
do cause the said Instrument (a Copy whereof
is hereunto annexed) to be prepared, for His
Royal Highness's Signature. -

Whereas it has been represented to Us, that
in the Month of July 1813, a Squadron of Our
Ships under the Command of Rear Admiral
Sir George Cockburn, Knight Commander of the
most Honourable Military Order of the Bath,
and a Detachment of Our 102nd Regiment, and
of the 2nd Battalion Royal Marines under the
Command of Lieutenant Colonel Charles Napier,
