Beckwith - Warren (cont)
August 13, 1813

The enemy having fled in a direction which precluded any hopes of cutting them off, or pursuing them with any success, I judged it advisable to march the Troops back to the Ferry at the Narrows, where they recrossed and returned to their encampment.

Our loss on this occasion is two Men wounded and one Horse killed by the fire of the Enemy's Pickets and one Man missing - I am sorry to say that two men of the 2nd Battalion Royal Marines were killed by accident, and one man wounded.
