His Majesty's Ship *Valiant*
Off New London 3rd November 1813

Sir,

The Provisions of the *Atalante*
being nearly expended and all her cables condemned as
it will appear by the enclosed report of survey.

I am under the necessity of sending her to Halifax
and to supply her place I have taken the *Loup Cer-*
-vier under my Orders which I hope will meet your
approbation as it is expected the *Hornet* will attempt
to get out the very first opportunity, she is manned
with 160 Men and there are 1000 on board the
United States and *Macedonian* all quite ready
for sea. - In moving down the River on the
30th Ultimo the *United States* grounded and con-
-tinued on shore till the next day when the other
two Ships moved up and assisted getting her off, they
are all now about 3 miles above the Town of New
