I have the Honor herewith to transmit You a Letter with Enclosure which I have received from Captain Barrie of His Majesty's Ship Dragon, and as the Service [detailed therein] reflects much Honor on Captain Alexander of the Devastation and those employed upon it under him, I beg to recommend them to your favorable Notice, particularly Lieutenant Nicholas Alexander who seems to have availed himself of an Opportunity ~~of~~ of signaling himself on this Occasion by a single Combat with one of the Enemy's Dragoons, and whose good Conduct has been repeatedly noticed by me on former Occasions.
