Sir,

Orders having been this day given to embark a force of seven thousand men at Bourdeaux for service in Canada, and to dispatch the same in two separate divisions to Quebec, I am directed by Lord Bathurst to request that you would move the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty to give the necessary orders for providing adequate Convoy for each of these divisions to the point of their destination.
