Sir,

Captain Walker's ~~next~~ ^{next} rendezvous is Point Negril off the west end of the Island of Jamaica, you will lose no time in completing your water and Provisions in Carlisle Bay, and hastening to follow him to Negril -

You are not to permit your destination to be known till you shall be twenty leagues to the Westward of Barbadoes, when if there be other ships of the Squadron in Company with you, you will give out Negril Point as the next rendezvous, in case of further separation.

When you shall have read this letter you are to seal it up again in an envelope addressed to the Senior Officer of any other Ship of Captain Walker's Squadron which may have parted Company, and may not have rejoined either him or you, and you will deliver it into the charge of the highest naval or Military authority at Carlisle Bay, with a request that it be returned unopened (except by the said Senior Officers) at the expiration of one Month -
