At a special meeting of the Board of the Young Mens Col. Society held this evening, the following preamble & Resolutions were adopted and a copy of the same ordered to be handed to you - viz

Whereas, this Board has seen two letters from the Students of the Washington Med. College to the faculty, expressing their desire that James F. McGill, be withdrawn from the College. - Therefore

Resolved. That J. F. McGill be withdrawn from said Institution.

Resolved, That the thanks of this Board be presented to the President & faculty of the Washington Medical College for their kindness to Saml. F. McGill during his attendance at said Institution.

Resolved. That the Committee heretofore appointed be directed to ascertain what future disposition shall be made of said McGill.

On Motion Resolved. That Messrs Woodward, St. Bernard, Wm. F. Giles, G. M. Rogers & Chas. A. Easter be appointed a Committee on behalf of this Board, to confer personally with the students of the Wash. Med. College, and respectfully request that Mr McGill may be suffered to attend in any capacity to further the object of the board in procuring Medical information.

Resolved. That the foregoing Resolutions be presented to the faculty of the Washington Med. College with the Request that the same may be read
