Mc Gill, the sum of One Hundred and ten $\frac{80}{100}$ Dollars, the same being an equal division of Two Thousand Six Hundred and fifty Nine $\frac{76}{100}$ Dollars placed in their hands by Wm. H. B. Latrobe Esq^r of Baltimore for equal distribution among the adult servants of the late Richard Putman of Georgia
