I give you my last to you in July
wherein I informed you that I had in my family a

timore, numbering five. They have recently returned

comodate the worthy & faithful Father Scotland
and should the Agents accompany him here I will
should be prefer^d it be pleased to accomodate him
during his stay with us. please present my
respects to them and accept the assurance of my
Esteem & Regard.
