Sharpsburg Sept 4th 1846

Dear Sir

Since I last wrote, Mr Scotland
I have visited Frederick, & a large meeting in
that neighbourhood - we arrived in this place
yesterday - several in Frederick promised to
go, but here, I am afraid, it will be a com-
plete failure - the family that promised from
Scotland, have been receiving news from Boston
that have changed their minds - Tomorrow we
go to Williamsport, and spend the Sabbath, from
thence to Clearspring Hagerstown Buckeystown
&c - When I get to Frederick again, I shall
hold a large meeting in one of the Colored
Churches - I want to return to Balt. through
Montgomery Co. - the people at the Camp
meeting manifested considerable interest, &
said they would try & make up a company
for Africa - I ^{wish} to be in Balt. by the first
of Oct. visit Lewis Co. again - I will make
every effort in my power to secure a large
number this fall - but, the Colored people are
so uncertain, I am sometimes most discour-
aged - To night I hold a meeting in this
place, when I will get the names of such as wish
to go - I expect to be in Frederick by the last
of next week -
