Dear Sir

Since I last wrote, I have spent the most of my time in this city, but without any certain success. I have held, since my arrival here, four Colonization Meetings - three in the Colored Churches, one in the U. E. Church. My meetings have been attended by Dr. Lugenbeel & the little Native boy - they were large, & considerable interest was manifested, yet, I could not obtain one single name for Africa - I have also talked with them in their houses &c. - I saw Smith & Gross, but could not prevail upon them to go this fall - both promised to go next year - Major Hughes will be in Balt. next week, I will call to see you - To day, I lease for Liberty Church to night - I shall spend several days in that neighbourhood, & next Sunday I expect to be in Rockville, in Montgomery Co. - from there, I shall, after, six or eight days, come to Balt. expecting to visit the Eastern Shore - If you have any directions for me, write to Rockville - The names in Williamsport, I think can be relied on
