


Dear Doctor

October 15th 1846

I leave Shepherds town this morning
for Washington City for the purpose of calling
on Mr. Hall for the bill of sale.
I shall on my arrival at Washington City
first call on Mr. M. M. McLain Agent for
the American Colonization Society, to ask
the favour of him to accompany me to
see Mr. Hall, that the papers may be acce-
-ted under his inspection.

I would take it as a special favour if
you would write to Mr. McLain immediately on
receipt of this asking him to ~~interpose~~ aid
me in the accomplishment of my objects
as I am persuaded a letter from you to
him would be of service to me as I have
but slight acquaintance with Mr. McLain.
A letter from you to Mr. McLain would
about reach him as soon as I shall,
as I am on Haverback and will require
about three days for me to reach Wash-
ington City.
