

Mr Hall

Oct 22nd 1846

Dear Sir

I arrived safe here, after a laborious ride, & went immediately to see Mr Hall & obtained a bill of sale for Mr Scotland's son - In the course of thirty minutes I shall start for Virginia, where I expect to arrive to morrow evening - Monday or Tuesday I hope to leave for Williamsport, & by the first of the next week at farthest you may expect to see me in Balt.

Mr Fletcher has not seen Mr Scotland since last Friday, & says that he has returned to Shepherdstown - I will write to him, to meet me at Mr Hall's plantation - And if he does not arrive in time, I will attend to the business and leave - Mr H was not disposed to refund the money -
