Sir

I was requested by Dr McJile  
to purchase for him a gold chain of  
one ounce weight, and to forward it  
to you for him, but understanding  
that he has left again for Africa, I  
have thought it probable that he might  
have left some instructions with you about  
it - I was not able to get one so light  
as required, but got one about one & a half  
ounce - If he has said any thing to you  
about it and you think that one will  
do him suit, I will forward it to you, by  
express as soon as I hear from you -  
the cost of the chain is 50 per cent upon  
the weight, calling the ounce \$16 -  
an early answer, will much  
oblige, yours Resp<sup>t</sup>
