Packet Dear Sir Mr Thomas is dead he  
deceased in December in 1847 and after his  
death being appointed administrator of his  
Estate I Received your letter and your Son  
James W Hall Delivered to me 1 Hh Tobacco  
and in cash the sum of 84,45 and that  
Tobacco and money I divided into three Shares  
Much as Nicholas Jackson of one of the four  
heirs had Drawen his Share While he was  
there and also I would like to know whether  
there is any more Money dueing his Estate or  
not and also I would like to know how his  
Bouisness Stands
