I also send to your care, 3 letters for Liberia, which please forward at the earliest opportunity.

I shall not send over any freight this time, for I know not whether my Wife is Dead, or not. For I have not heard one word from her since last Feb.

I was informed by my Journal for Dec, that the Packet would sail for Liberia on the 15th ult. And she has sailed before this reaches you, please write me a line at my expense.

I sincerely thank you Sir, for your favor of the 15th ult.
