Cambridge July 10. 1849

Mr Harker & Capt Alfried called on me today relative to the bill of Costs against Jefferson. The Original bill which Alfried agreed to take \$3. for is upwards of \$6, which he refuses to take now - and has transferred I understand the bill back again to Harker -

Mr Harker threatens he shall not leave Baltimore unless he pay the claim - As the boy has no means whatever I don't know what will be done unless he is wanted and then he must remain until he pays the debt or gets clear by the insolvent law.

As he is in your hands you must do the best you can in the premises - I fear other may press on their bills for attendance at Court - if so there is very little hope for him -
