Dear Sir - In reply to your
 answer to my letter of Enquiry -
 I have to say that John Henry &
 Diego Evans, the Liberia Emigrants
 to whom I referred, will want to
 be accommodated with freight to
 the amount of 80 Babels at least -
 instead of 50. - They will have
 from \$1500 to \$2000 to invest, & it
 is their intention to repair to
 Baltimore & procure your advice
 & aid in their purchases. There is
 another man, Harry McClure who
 will have 2 or \$300 to invest, & I
 hope you will be able to keep open
 rooms for his accommodation also until
 it is determined how much he will
