Yours of date current is at hand, & I take at once an opportunity to answer it. In the last report I made I specified the Horses.

Hances was yours and he paid Aug. 14 th \$30.00 on account. I allowed him to the 1st of January next to pay the balance which was 30; putting the horse at \$60.
