^{or shades} are not wanting with the lamp. The lamp should
not stand higher than one foot - and should be
as plain as possible. The combustion of Palm
Oil ~~causes~~ the rapid destruction of the metal
that supports the wick, can any means be adop-
ted to prevent this, or can any more durable
metal be substituted. The entire bill of
cost should not exceed the Fifty dollars appor-
portioned.
