

Snow Hill June 26<sup>th</sup> 1857

Dear Bro Sup. or Dr Hall

I have sent on Henry Dennis wife & son who wish to go to Liberia, the others have declined going at present, I sent on their good to Baltimore in a safe and gave the Capt an order on you for the money. I have sent Henry & family on in the Steam boat. their passage will be \$3.75. It cost me \$5.00 to get them from here to the boat. which amount you can remit me by mail. Henry leaves here with a very good character. He will show you his recommendation,
