At a meeting of the Protestant Episcopal
Mission at Cape Palmas, N.C., held June 23rd,
1851, the following Resolutions were adopted, viz.

Resolved, That the afflictive providence
which has removed from our midst the late la-
mented Governor of the Maryland Colony, in Vir-
beria, John B. Russwurm, Esq., calls forth our
deepest feelings of regret for the loss thus sus-
tained by his bereaved family, - the Common-
wealth, - the Church, - and ourselves.

Resolved, That in the discharge of his ar-
duous and responsible duties as the Chief Execu-
tive Officer of this Colony his measures were
characterized by a wise and prudent policy, and
executed with rare energy and fidelity. His judi-
