

Hagers-Dunn, Aug. 2. 1851.

Dear Sir,  
I was requested a few days ago to notify you, as the Agent of the Maryland State Colonization Society, of the design of two of our free colored men to go out to Cape Palmas in the next packet, to be sent by the Society. They are Thomas Tilghman and William Pindell, both of this place, the latter formerly a slave of Mrs. Reynolds, & manumitted, as I am informed, by her will.

These persons desire to know whether their passage will be free, and what else they should be informed of as applicants for a passage & for a residence there in the colony. You can communicate with me on the subject.
