4 year

In the Conclusion, we Humbly Pray, Gentlemen that you will
Grant our Request & prayers. Feeling Convinced within our own
Bosom, the Honorable Board has ever been our Foster parent to Act
& to Do, for our best Interest & Prosperity, our Hopes that the above
will be Received By you, Coming from us, as a people who
Desire not to Disturb to your Honorable Body, no further then
to you, what we necessarily Require for the promoting of our pros-
perity.
