Dear Sir

in hast I set down to write you a few  
lines hoping they may find you in good health  
I have just received my Repository and I  
see that a vessel is to sail from Baltimore  
on the 25 of this month when I wrote you  
before I ask you to let me know when  
they would be an opportunity to write and you  
felt to do so in the letter I write you I stated  
that I did not receive my reply of letter ~~of~~  
before I receive an answer from you I receive my  
full reply in one of the letters I receive stating  
that they was a box to be sent to me but  
they did not know how I would get it and  
I ~~wish~~ want to beg you if it is sent to  
you if you wont receive it and write me  
a word immediately and I will send the  
money to pay the freight and instruct you  
how to ship it to in Savannah that  
I may receive it safe and you would oblige  
me very much

and for any information you  
can give me concerning the sailing of the  
vessel please to write me an answer as quick  
as this is received I remain yours truly
