

Dr James Hall Baltimore. November 5th 1851

Dear Sir I write this for the purpose of resigning my situation as Clerk of the Maryland State Colonization Society, and in doing so I must state, that I feel bound to settle and balance the Books of the Society to the 31st of October, when my quarter terminated, and will do so during the coming week, if possible, Sickness and other causes arising from the settlement of my deceased father's estate have compelled me to this measure as self preservation is the first law of nature,

I cannot take leave of you in this abrupt manner without expressing to you my appreciation of the many kindnesses received at your hands, and beg to be considered.
