My Dear Sir
I arrived from Green-
field last evening and leave again
in an hour for Washington. I cannot
see you, and therefore write.

The Committee on
our cause in the Conference will present
a fair and true report. I have a copy which
you may put in our next Journal if you
think fit. I did not address the Conference,
as the report was not ready to be presented
before I left.

I went to Harrods, Frostburg,
&c. and picked up \$20 for our funds, &
sold 44 of Fuller's Journal for the other
24 I left with Rev. G. J. Marks to be
sold by him. In another interview
with the Marks of Cumberland I find
them working up to the subject of emigration.
I hope to see you early next week.
