

Cambridge June 29 1852

Sir

I have just arrived from below & have succeeded
very well so far. I sent you the letter that I
received and I wish you to write to me and
let me know if you received it, and if I shall
send the others to you I shall be in Cambridge
about four days. I have not collected one cent
I found that those who come to the Convention
shall have to beg their expenses from the whites
and as the time is so short I thought it would
be best to let them have a chance. And for the
the letter from Mr. Lattrobe does not authorize
me to collect money. Please write as soon
as you receive this
